BOMA EARTH AWARD WINNER

We are honored to inform you that Post Montgomery Center was selected as the 1st place winner in the Large Commercial Building Category in San Francisco BOMA's 1st Annual Earth Awards Program.

This program is designed to recognize a property's practices which reflect the building's physical impact on the environment. These factors include the building's efforts to reduce water and energy usage, reducing the use of toxics, recycling practices to reduce trash output and purchasing practices. The analysis is based on an initial survey to pre-qualify each property for an on site physical inspection which is then conducted by a committee composed of representatives from Pacific Gas & Electric, San Francisco Water Department, San Francisco Department of the Environment, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, Golden Gate Disposal and Building Owner's and Manager's Association.
